

## Middle School Summer Reading Requirements

Due: Wednesday, September 8

Directions: You are expected to read **three grade-level** (5<sup>th</sup> grade and up) novels over the summer and take Accelerated Reader tests on those books. Please keep track of the key details in the novel including: main characters, plot, setting, theme, etc. You have a Bingo sheet containing a number of activities to complete. You are expected to complete at least five activities. You will be completing a project in the fall. You will have a number of project options from which to choose. The more information and documentation you have, the more creative and engaging your project will be!

A list of historical fiction novels are included for both grades. These books are not required reading; however, they cover the time period you will be studying in 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Social Studies and US History.

The novels, the Accelerated Reader tests, and the project will count as three separate grades. Each Accelerated Reader test will be out of 10 points, the project rubric will be distributed in the fall, and the novels will be graded in the following manner:

Three books read	100%
Two books read	70%
One book read	50%
Zero books read	0%
